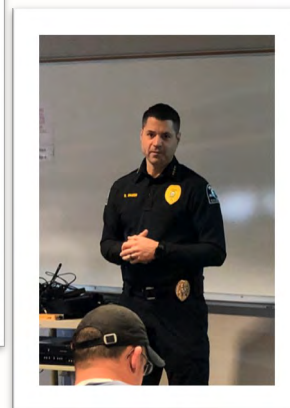
### Our Trainers
