

Omaha gas station faces penalties after cited for selling alcohol to a minor for the second time in two years

OMAHA, Neb. — An Omaha gas station is facing a mandatory closure for selling liquor to minors.

The Kwik Shop on north 72nd Street was cited for selling alcohol to a minor for the second time in two years.

Penalty guidelines include a two-day mandatory closure of all alcohol sales and a 40-day suspension.

That suspension can be paid as a fine of one hundred dollars per day.

Almost two dozen other businesses are facing their first violations of selling to minors.

The compliance checks involved 40 officers from five cities, two counties, and state patrol.
